Covid and symptoms

If your child is symptomatic, you must arrange for a PCR test and let school know. If this is positive, you will need to follow NHS/track and trace isolation guidance. If negative you can come back to school.

If a member of your household is positive, please let school know. Your child can continue to come to school as long as they do NOT have any symptoms. I have put a short parent guide on the website too with this information in. You can find this in the parent information section.

If your child is poorly with covid symptoms in school, we will call you to collect your child and arrange a test. We can help families with getting PCR tests.

We will continue to work with Public Health in terms of cases in school, and will always take any further guidance from them as necessary.
